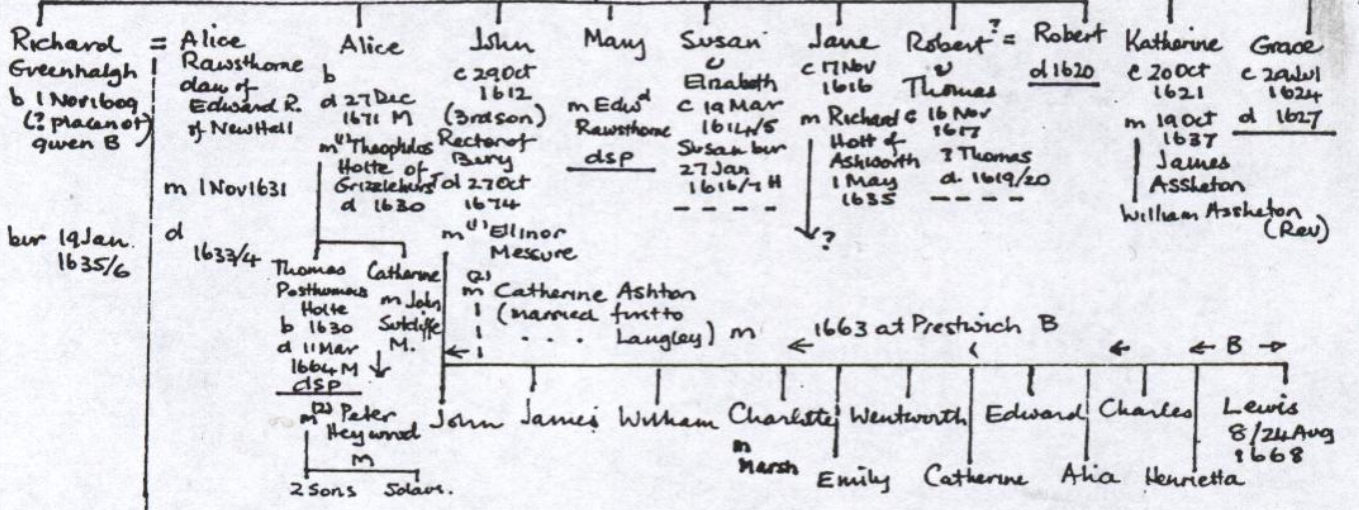

 Bailiff of the Earl of Derby Governor of the Isle of Man Lived at Brandlesome & at Chamber Hall

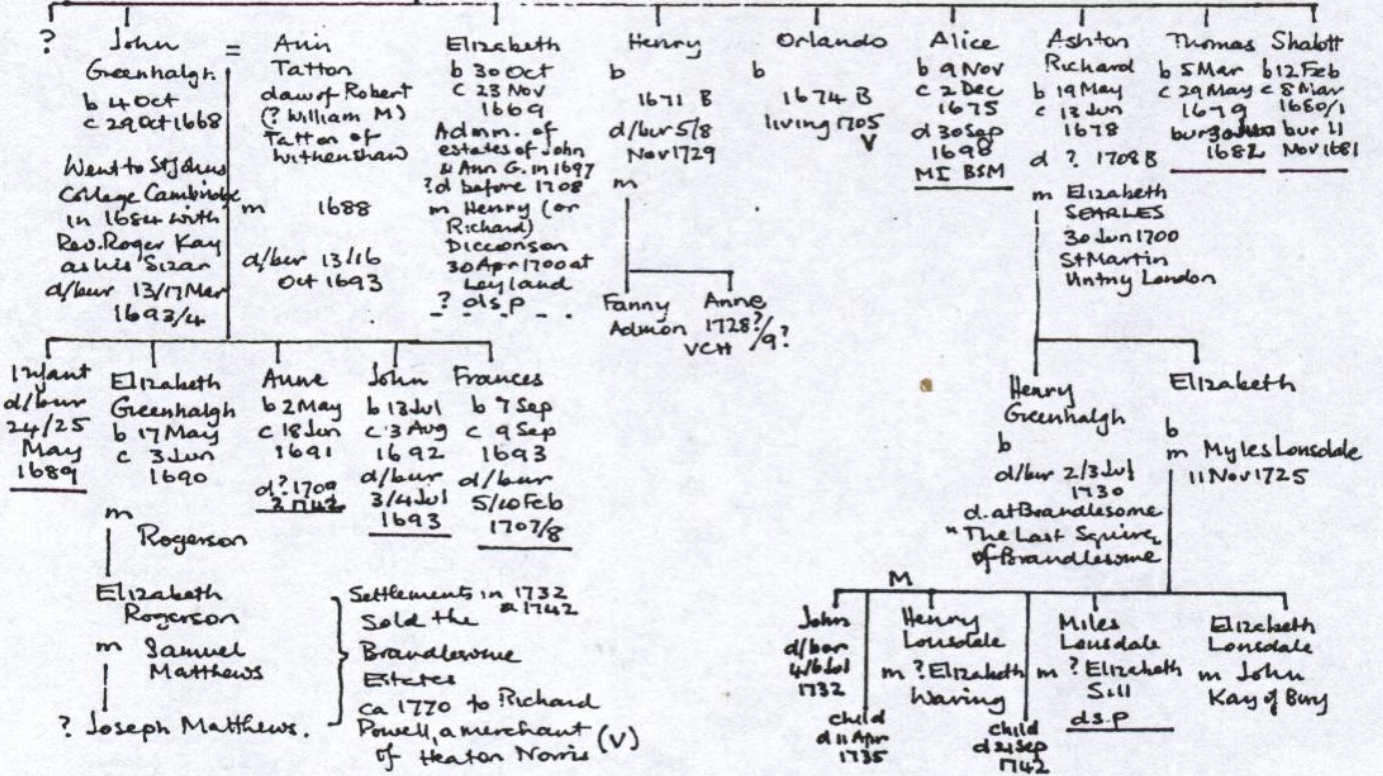

 In 1662 Thomas Greenhalgh & his sons John, Henry, Orlando & Richard were made Burgesses at Preston Guild
